Leadership Award

This award shall be given to a woman who:

- Lives or works in one of the Downriver communities.
- Represents a SWCRC member business or non-profit
- Has exemplified the attributes of a community leader including volunteerism, advocacy, outstanding business relations and the betterment of the community of the Downriver region.
- Is a professional or an entrepreneur.
- Has incorporating sustainability principles into corporate culture, products and services.
- Has focusing on positive environmental and social impact of business activities.

Entrepreneur Award

This award shall be given to a woman who:

- Lives or works in one of the Downriver communities.
- Represents a SWCRC member business or non-profit
- Has embarked on a business venture with vision and ambition.
- Has incorporated sustainability principles into corporate culture, products and services
- Focuses on positive environmental and social impact of business activities.

Unsung Heroine Award

The Unsung Heroine Award recognizes a woman who has had a significant impact on a Chamber member business or non-profit from “behind the scenes.”

- Lives or works in one of the Downriver communities.
- Has positively influenced a program, organization or community from “behind the scenes” with a positive attitude, a willingness to help in whatever capacity necessary, and a commitment to excellence.
- Has done good works without expecting an increase in compensation or recognition.

Community Award

The award will recognize an individual in the Downriver community who has championed the promotion of women in leadership roles in business or nonprofit management. A nominee must:

- Be a person in good standing with the Downriver community
