

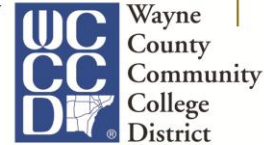

Each year, students from the Roosevelt High School agriculture class have the opportunity to gain experience in floral design through the Student Floral Contest. Our exhibitors play a large part in encouraging these students as they work toward their career goals. Arrangements will be judged prior to the Black Tie Gala & Expo, and any ribbons awarded will be displayed on the arrangements in your booths.

If you would be willing to support a student in the Floral Contest, complete the form below and return it to the Chamber with your payment. Upon your purchase of an arrangement, you will receive a call from a student asking you questions about your business and your booth display so that he or she can create an arrangement that will enhance your booth.

The benefits to the students include the opportunity to work with "customers" and to work on-site with professional florist so they may experience working in an actual flower shop. The \$60 price (\$63 if paying by credit card) allows them to create large, stylized arrangements valued at \$100 or more that they would not get to work on otherwise because of the cost of producing these arrangements.
